Frankie Anibal Gutierrez, 46, of Newnan passed away Thursday, September 2, 2021 at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. Frankie was born July 29, 1975 in Brooklyn, NY to Julio Gutierrez & Milagros Bracero.

Frankie honorably served his country in the U.S. Army and later in the Air Force Reserves. He was a police officer for 24 years, the last three years with the Newnan Police Department.

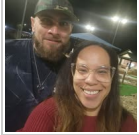

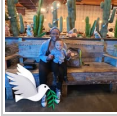

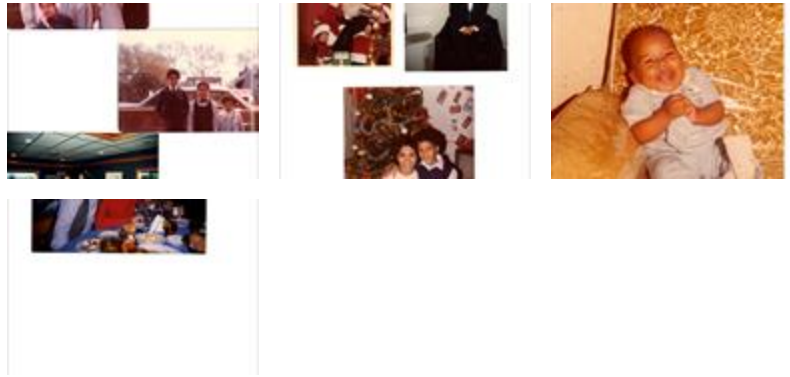
