Franklin Chase Higgins was a young man of big dreams and immense talent. On the morning of December 15, 2016, his day began much like any other as he left his home and headed to Greenville High School for another day of instilling his love of learning in the minds of his students. That day, however, would be the day that he would come face to face with the God in heaven that he loved so deeply and to whom he had dedicated his life. Chase was born in Newnan on June 14, 1988. He attended Newnan High School where he first developed a love for music and participated in the marching band. He also played lacrosse. Following his graduation in 2006 he attended Texas State University and graduated in 2015 with a degree in physics and a minor in applied mathematics. He taught math at Greenville High School. Chase was a person of great passions that found expression in his music. Open mic nights were a great opportunity for him to grab a guitar and belt out a few tunes. His great love of the outdoors would lead him to many happy days swimming and fishing or romping with his faithful dog companion Gamble. Foremost in his life, though, were his love for the God who created him and his love for his family. He was active in and dedicated to the youth ministry of Crossroads church. While Chase's life may have been shorter than some, his impact was heartfelt in the lives of his family, friends and students who benefitted from his life of love and service. Chase is survived by his parents Jaime and Melanie King Higgins of Moreland; his brother Levi T. Higgins and his sister Bonnie Hussey and her husband Zack of Seattle WA. His grandparents are Gwyn and

Tom Wills of Olar, SC; Terry and Betty King of Pinson, AL. His nieces are Gracie and Delilah Hussey and his nephew is Noah Hussey. There is an extended family of aunts, uncles and cousins. Visitation with the family will be on Sunday evening between 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM.
