



Frederic Raymond Blackwell

December 24, 1937 - July 8, 2011

Frederic Raymond "Fred" Blackwell, age 73, of Newnan, died July 8, 2011 at Newnan Hospital Nursing and Rehabilitation Center as a result of complications related to cancer. Fred was born December 24, 1937 in Seminary, Mississippi and was one of three children born to the late Dwight Moody and Bessie Jones Blackwell. In 1960, Fred earned his Bachelor of Science Degree at Mississippi College. He later attended what is now The University of West Georgia and attained his Masters of Education in 1971 and his Specialist in Education in 1981. He retired from the Atlanta Public School System in 1993. Fred was a man of great compassion and found a second career in the Department of Patient and Family Services with Piedmont Newnan Hospital. It was an opportunity for service that he enjoyed for 10 years. Fred truly enjoyed his life that was filled with friends and generously shared his talents as a decorator and his love for flowers and landscaping. He held a deep appreciation for all things of beauty including the fine arts. He was a fierce defender of all that should be right in the world and when entrusted with the duty to preserve and conserve the assets left to the citizens of Newnan by the late Edgar B. Hollis, he left no stone unturned towards that end. Surviving Fred is his wife of 47 years, Nell Williams Blackwell of Newnan; a brother, Dwight Moody Blackwell, Jr. of LaVerne, California and a nephew, Anthony Harrison Blackwell of Hattiesburg, Mississippi.
