



Garner Boyd Clark

June 25, 1937 - July 21, 2023

Mr. Garner Boyd Clark, 86 of Senoia, Georgia passed away Friday, July 21, 2023, peacefully at home. Boyd was born on June 25th, 1937, in Knoxville, Tennessee to the late Garner and Nellie Clark. In addition to his parents, Boyd was preceded in death by his wife and love of his life Nellie Glen Clark. Boyd was also preceded by his sister Katherine Clark, his brother Larry Clark and his son Willie Eugene Clark.

Garner B grew up in Knoxville, Tennessee and joined the Marine Reserves in 1954. Soon after, Boyd spent some years searching for his future and found it when he moved to Georgia, where he met the love of his life Nellie. Shortly after they were married (1958), Boyd was inducted into the U.S. Army (1962) and was stationed in Germany, where him and Nell created a world of their own, surrounded by foreign faces and unfamiliar places. After his military service, Boyd and Nell moved back to Georgia and after, once again, spending some time searching for their future, Boyd opened his own business, C & W Roofing Co. Inc. They ran a successful and prosperous business for decades alongside an ever-expanding family.

Boyd's viewing will be Friday, July 28th at 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at McKoon Funeral Home, 38 Jackson Street, Newnan, Ga 30263. The graveside service will be the following morning, Saturday, July 29th at 10 am at Senoia City Cemetery, off of Stallings Road, Senoia, Ga, 30276, where anyone who would

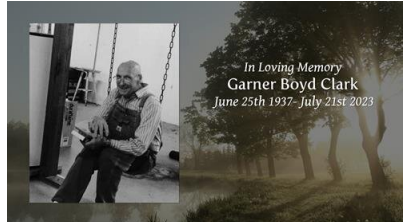

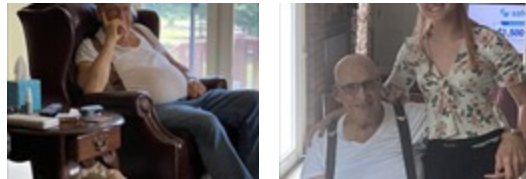
