George Edward Johnson, Jr. passed away on the evening of March 27, 2015. Mr. Johnson was born on May 24, 1949 in Newnan, Georgia, Coweta County to George E. Johnson, Sr. and Helen Nadine Dye Johnson. He was the oldest of two children born to Mr. and Mrs. Johnson. George attended elementary school through the third grade in Newnan and move to Albany, Georgia where he lived with his family until age twelve.
