

George Joseph Lauzon, Jr.

April 26, 1940 - February 19, 2025

Mr. George Joseph Lauzon, Jr., age 84, passed away at his home in Gay, Georgia, on February 19, 2025, with his family by his side. He was born on April 26, 1940, in Brockton, Massachusetts, to the late George Joseph Lauzon, Sr., and Leona Helen Makein. He is also preceded in death by his brother, Frank (Mary) Lauzon and his grandson, James J. Lauzon, Jr.

Not only was he a devoted husband, dad, papa and friend, he was a proud United States Marine Corps veteran. George grew up with a deep sense of duty and honor. After graduating high school, he answered the call to serve his country, enlisting in the United States Marine Corps on September 5, 1958 in Boston, Massachusetts. During his honorable service, George rose to the rank of Lance Corporal (E-3) and served as a Radio Field Operator, ensuring critical communication lines remained strong and secure. Stationed with the Headquarters Company, 2nd Marines, Fleet Marine Force at Lejeune, NC, George embodied the Marine Corps' core values of honor, courage, and commitment. Throughout his active duty, George's dedication and exemplary conduct earned him the 'Good Conduct Medal (2nd Award)', reflecting his unwavering discipline and integrity. He completed his service with honor, receiving an honorable discharge on September 4, 1962, before transferring to the Marine Corps Reserves in MCR, Quantico, VA.

George brought the same dedication and determination to the business

community, proudly owning and running Ronnie's Variety Store from 1981-2010. Owning his own business wasn't just a job-it was a reflection of his character. He took pride in every project, every handshake, and every relationship he built along the way. George treated his customers like friends and his employees like family, always leading with honesty, integrity, and a touch of his signature humor. His dedication to his work and community left a lasting impact, one built not just on hard work, but on heart.

Beyond his military service, George was known for his quick wit, infectious laughter, a sense of humor that could captivate a room and a smile that would light up the world. He had a knack for telling stories- and enjoyed any chance he could get to be the center of attention. George was the kind of man who never met a stranger, only friends he hadn't gotten around to yet. George's legacy isn't just in the stories he told or the laughter he sparked-it's in the way he made people feel. Loved. Seen. Valued. He had a way of reminding everyone that life wasn't meant to be taken too seriously and that a little laughter could go a long way.

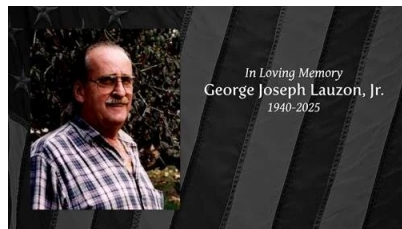
