- My Mama could cook!
- My Mama worked hard growing her own garden and canning lots of vegetables. She raised chickens for eggs and meat.
- Mama quit her job at Southern Mills in our home town of Senoia, GA, to be the best homemaker a girl could have.
- Mama started her own sewing business from home. A lot of people in and around our town knew my Mama, and many brought their alterations and sewing to her. Mama sewed A LOT of cheerleading outfits, chorus dresses, drill team outfits, and more for me and my sister and our friends. I didn't have a store bought dress that I recall until I was about 15. Mama made all my dresses. She even made a pair of jeans once – best fittin' jeans ever!
- Mama went to ALL my basketball and softball games, as well as my chorus performances. She was so excited about my teams State Championship play offs in 1981 that she went to the games sick - turns out she had pneumonia. Mama loved to watch me play - and she was a fantastic ball player herself. And yes, we won State!
- Mama did most of the house work by herself. (That's one I'm not really proud of. Sorry Mama).
- Mama never missed church. Sunday morning, Sunday night, and Wednesday - we were there!
- I loved Mama's biscuits. She made them in an iron skillet from scratch. The center biscuits had less of a crust since they didn't touch the side of the pan. Mama always gave me the center biscuits because she knew I loved them the most.
- Mama could not sing at all! That didn't stop her from joining the choir though. The folks at Open Door Baptist Church always asked me to stand by Mama, because I was the only one in the choir that could still sing in tune with Mama beside me. Mama always said that God said to "make a joyful noise. He didn't say anything about a purty noise." I bet she's singing purty now up in heaven!
