

## Glenda Faye Richardson

May 22, 1940 - December 10, 2018

Mrs. Glenda Wilson Richardson, 78, of Bowdon, Georgia passed away on December 10, 2018 after a lengthy illness surrounded by her children Billy, Debbie, Angela and James. She was born in Bowdon on May 22, 1940, the daughter of the late Lloyd Maxwell (Pete) Wilson and Pauline Wright Wilson. 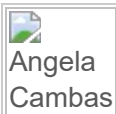

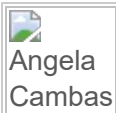
