



## Guy Wesley McKoon

May 31, 1945 - September 27, 2022

Mr. Guy Wesley McKoon, 77, of Newnan, passed away Tuesday, September 27, 2022, at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. He was born May 31, 1945 in Newnan, Ga, to the late Guy Waymon "Buck" McKoon and Grace McKoon Ferell. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Thomas "Tommy" McKoon. Survivors include his wife of 54 years, Belvie Hosey McKoon of Newnan; son Brian McKoon of Newnan, daughter Melissa McKoon Proctor and husband, Chris, of Newnan; grandchildren Michaela Proctor of Newnan, and Christopher Proctor of Newnan.
