Guy Smith Williamson was born in Atlanta, Georgia on March 16, 1927 into a loving Christian family. His parents were the late Walter G. and Karl Smith Williamson. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by two brothers, Jimmy and Charles. On May 30, 1948, Guy married the love of his life, Judy Heaton. Their marriage has been blessed by three children, Lynn and her husband Carl Smith, Paul and his wife Isabel Zamudio, John and his wife Juliana Page. His children, six grandchildren, 9 great grandchildren and nieces, nephews and cousins were always the light of his family focused life.
