Harriett B. Barron of Newnan, Georgia died on July 15, 2012. She was born at Emory Hospital on July 29, 1934 to W. Edgar Bailey and Marguaree Watson Bailey of Lithonia. Harriett lived with her parents in Lithonia through high school where she was a cheerleader and All District basketball player at Lithonia High. She was an Honor Graduate of the Terry School of Business at the University of Georgia and also president of the Alpha Delta Pi sorority.

After college, Harriett briefly taught school and later worked in advertising until her marriage to George S. Barron, Jr. She and her husband lived for some time in San Juan, Puerto Rico, Atlanta, Georgia, and then settled in Newnan, Georgia.
