On April 19, 2017 Harry Charles Tysinger Jr. went to be with his Lord and Savior. Harry was born June 8, 1936 to Lillian and Harry Tysinger Sr. He is survived by his wife of 49 years Judy, children Laura Tysinger Houwers (Bill), Harry Charles Tysinger III, and Jenny Tysinger Raspberry, grandchildren Matthew Raspberry, Moriah and Claire Houwers, and Lily and Meara Tysinger, brother Richard Lee Tysinger (Ann), numerous nieces and nephews, and his beloved dog Millie.

Harry attended Florida State University and University of Miami and received a degree in Business. He worked in construction during his early career and later worked as a pilot for Eastern Airlines. He retired from Eastern as a Captain after 20 years of service. Prior to his retirement he received a degree in Pastoral Studies and served as a Chaplain for the Coweta County Sheriff's Department and the Peachtree City Police Department.

Harry's faith was the cornerstone of his life and he loved Jesus Christ and enjoyed serving the Lord. He served on the Vestry at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Newnan and as a Deacon at Trinity Fellowship in Sharpsburg. He also spent many hours teaching and counseling others in the faith.

Harry lived in Newnan for 30 years before moving to Florida. For the past 17 years Harry and Judy have resided in Carrabelle, FL where he found his "place on the beach", aptly named Buddy's Beach, the name his grandchildren called him. In his later years he spent many hours fishing, boating, playing bridge, and enjoying the beauty of God's creation.
