Helen Baxley Swope, age 90, of Tucker, Georgia passed away on December 16, 2016. Mrs. Swope was born in Mt. Holly, NC and was a graduate of Mt. Holly High School in 1945 and received her B.A. from Brenau College in 1950. Mrs. Swope was active in the Alpha Gamma Delta Sorority from her college days until her death. An extremely active member of Embry Hill United Methodist Church, Mrs. Swope was a member of the Harding Sunday School Class since 1968, chaired the Worship Committee for over two decades and volunteered her time and skill in the church office. Mrs. Swope was talented in needlepoint and quilting, hand sewing over 30 full sized quilts and numerous smaller works and baby blankets. Mrs. Swope enjoyed travel throughout the U.S. and Europe and she had a special love for the Williamsburg, VA area. Serving as the unofficial family historian, Mrs. Swope passed on artifacts, stories and the memories of both the Baxley and Swope families to her children and grandchildren. 
