He was born November 7, 1938 in Coweta County and was a son of the late Ernest Hubert and Vassie Oda Mae Brown Staley. This little guy would come to be called "Sack" by everyone. He attended school and was raised in the Grantville area of Coweta County. He would later join the United States Army. Coming back home from the service, he would work for The American Can Company which later became James River Corporation and would be in their service for 26 years until his retirement. In addition to his parents, Jack was predeceased by his wife Barbara June Staley and a son, Jackson Dean Staley. He is survived by his son, Sidney Dewayne Staley; step-daughter Dawn Veronica Johnson; step-sons Donald E. Johnson and Rev. C. David Johnson. His granddaughter is Courtney Dean Staley Johnson. 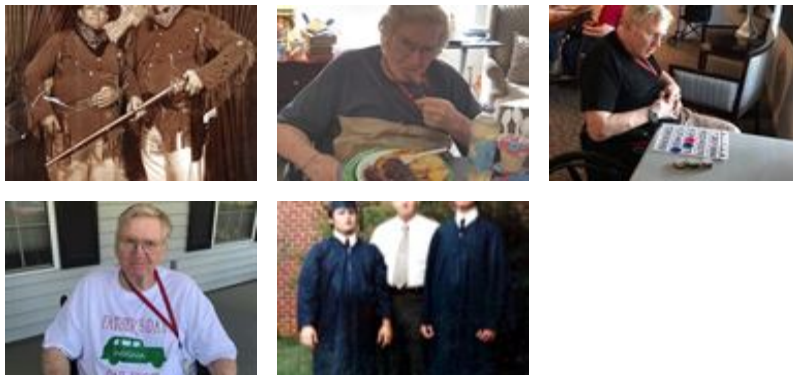
