A giving heart and a spirit to help others, Hubert was a great blessing to many people there and in the many places that his life took him around the world.

Not one to sit still, Hubert and his wife JoAnne were avid travelers and enjoyed many trips together, innumerable cities, destinations, making new friends and seeing the world around them.
