



## James William Ferrell

July 25, 1928 - September 24, 2014

James William Ferrell, age 86, died September 24, 2014 at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. James was born in Coweta County on July 25, 1928. His parents, William Thomas Ferrell and Annie Lou Dukes Ferrell preceded him in death. As did so many young men of his age, he first worked in the local textile mills. At the age of 18, he joined the United States Army to help with the war effort. He became a squad leader with Company A, 187th Glider Infantry stationed at Camp Crawford, Japan. Upon returning home after the war, he married Mary Broome in 1948. He also participated in the Veterans Adult Academic Education classes and graduated from that program in 1952. His working career was with Roadway Freight. James was a dedicated member of Macedonia Baptist Church where he had served as a deacon since 1978. For 65 years he had been a devoted husband to Mary Broome Ferrell. His children are James Thomas (Tommy) Ferrell and his wife Carol, Pamela (Pam) Diane Ferrell Clemons and her husband Tommy, Gregory (Greg) Don Ferrell and his wife Dianne. James was the doting "Granddaddy" to Jenny and Ed Legg, Jamie Ferrell, Eddie and Erin Royal, Amy and Joey Smith, Summer Royal Bryant, Kati Ferrell, Cassie Ferrell, Claire Ferrell. There are ten great grandchildren. His surviving siblings are Sanders Ferrell and Wilma Ferrell.
