Mr. James Wiley Cash, known to all as simply "J.W." passed away peacefully at his home on May 4, 2014. A native of Coweta County, He lived his entire life in his beloved Handy community. He was born October 29, 1928 and was the son of the late Frank R. and Sarah Carnes Cash. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Eugene Cash. Also preceding him in death was his beloved wife Barbara Sherrer Cash in 1998. J. W. served his country in The United States Army. J. W. and Barbara planted deep roots in the Handy community. They were heavily invested in the life of Elim Baptist Church where J. W. served as a deacon, sang in the choir and was instrumental in any projects that were ongoing. The annual fish fry was one of the rituals he truly enjoyed. J. W. was also one of the original trustees for the Elim cemetery maintenance fund. His working career spanned approximately 40 years with Royal Molded Products where he was in charge of quality control. J. W. is survived by his son, Jimmy Cash and his wife Tammy.
