



## Jane Elizabeth Anderson

June 19, 1956 - June 1, 2025

Jane Elizabeth Anderson Coffey passed peacefully in the early morning hours of June 1, 2025 nestled in the comfort of her home, Kinsale Farm, and surrounded by her loving family after bravely battling the devastation of Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) for two years. Jane's legacy leaves behind a bereft family who will miss her unwavering strength, incredibly quick and dry humor, brave resiliency, and unconditional love.

Born in the mid-1950s as the third and youngest child of the late Jack and Marion Anderson (née McGrew), she grew up alongside an older brother and sister in the Northeast, primarily based in Schenectady, New York. Jane entered the workforce as a bank teller, working her way up through management training programs to eventually become the General Manager of the Business Council of New York State, where she managed an Investment Portfolio of over 3,000 companies. After her tenure at the Business Council, Jane founded the National Employee Resource Alliance, which was acquired by Zurich Financial Group where she continued working after the acquisition as Vice President of Financial Marketing Services.

After retirement in 2000, the family moved to Florida, and Jane founded the First Aid Resource Group, working in tandem with the American Red Cross during the hurricane seasons to help people affected and displaced by the devastation of hurricanes Charlie and Francis. She then became an EMT and worked at Daytona International Speedway. She also volunteered with the Coast Guard Auxiliary as a cutter pilot, arguably one of her favorite jobs.

In 2006, as the family relocated to Newnan, Georgia to be closer to Delta's hub in Atlanta, Jane dabbled in several professional fields before settling into her position working in airport customer service at Delta Air Lines.

Jane is survived by her loving husband Bob Coffey; her daughter, Charlotte Coffey and her husband, Justin Hale; her son, Jack Coffey and his wife, Nicole; and future granddaughter, Sophie Jane Coffey; her sister, Karen Harvey (née Anderson) and her husband, Tom; and her brother, Chris Anderson and his wife, Patti.

A memorial service will be held on her 69th birthday on June 19, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. at McKoon Funeral Home & Crematory, 38 Jackson St., Newnan, GA.

The family will receive friends from 3:00 p.m. until service time.
