Jason Allen Sandlin, 45, of Newnan passed away unexpectedly from a pulmonary embolism on Tuesday, December 3, 2019. He was born February 12, 1974 in the old Newnan Hospital to Charles Morris Sandlin and Mary Walton Sandlin.

Jason grew up in Newnan and was a 1992 graduate of Newnan High School. He was a security technician with his family's security company, Security Plus. Jason was an affable person who made many friends with his quick wit and sense of humor. He enjoyed playing golf and the camaraderie that came with it. Never one to miss a chance to cheer on his beloved Georgia Bulldawgs, he will be in Heaven rooting for them in the SEC Championship. More than his love for his family and the Bulldawgs, was his love for Jesus. Jason loved worshipping with his family and leading family devotions. Jason met the love of his wife, Rebecca Stoltz Sandlin, in 1978 at the First Baptist Church Preschool. Jason and Rebecca began dating in 2010 and were married in 2012 creating a beautiful blended family they dubbed the Sandlin six pack. 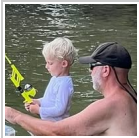

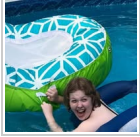
