Mr. Jeffrey Scott Patrick, 56, of Newnan, Ga passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, November 10, 2019, at his home on Welcome Road in Newnan. He was born on September 12, 1963, in Atlanta, Ga, to Kenneth and the late Margaret Ellen (Gordon) Patrick.

After realizing his call to the ministry as a Missionary, he went on various long-term mission trips, including Sault Ste Marie, Michigan and his longest

mission trip in Catalina Island in California.

He loved to spend his spare time reading, and he especially loved to study the Bible. He truly loved his church family and many friends at Providence. He was an avid sports fan, and he especially loved his home teams, the Atlanta Braves, and the Atlanta Falcons.

The family will receive friends at Providence Baptist Church from 1:00 pm until 2:00 pm on Sunday, November 17, 2019. A memorial service will immediately follow at the church at 2:00 pm, with Pastor Ken Norton and Pastor David Patrick officiating.
