September 14, 1924 - June 11, 2013

Mr. Joe Peniston "Penny" Storey, 88, passed away Tuesday, June 11, 2013 surrounded by his family at his home in Newnan. He was born September 14, 1924 in Newnan to the late Luther Addison Storey & Sarah Forbus Storey. Mr. Penny was a member of Newnan First United Methodist Church where he joined at the age of 11. At the age of 22, he began working at a local dry cleaner. He and his wife owned and operated Penny's Cleaners for many years before retiring in 1990. Mr. Storey was an active Master Mason and a member of Coweta Lodge #60 F&AM where he served as the Grand Master several times.
