John Brice, 100, of Newnan, GA passed away quietly on Saturday, July 22, 2023 at Wesley Woods. He was born May 6, 1923 in Cedar Rapids, Iowa to the late John Thomas Brice & Caroline Stark. He is survived by his wife, Luine Miller.

John grew up in Cedar Rapids, Iowa and was a 1946 graduate of Franklin High School. He graduated in Chemistry from Coe College, where he was a member of the Phi Kappa Phi fraternity. John married his childhood sweetheart Jeanne' Belknap before joining the U.S. Army where he was stationed in Europe and was a veteran of World War II. Afterwards, he received his Masters from Virginia Tech. He then moved to Atlanta, Georgia where he began his career at Goodyear Tire and Rubber and later moved to Hudson, Ohio. After Jeanne's death in 2006, he moved to Newnan, Georgia where he met his second wife Luine. He was a longtime member of the Presbyterian Church of Hudson, Ohio before moving to Newnan.
