



## John Charles Mansour

June 3, 1946 - May 30, 2010

John Charles Mansour, 63, a native of Newnan, GA passed away on May 30, 2010 surrounded by his beloved wife and sons. Born to the late Michael Vincent Mansour and Mayme Bohorfoush Mansour, John Charles graduated from Newnan High School in 1964 and attended Lees-McRae College in Banner Elk, NC.

Together with his brother, Ellis A. Mansour, Charlie owned and operated Brothers Ltd. clothing store on the square in Newnan for 44 years. Charlie was known and loved for his beautiful smile and warm greeting. He loved to visit with his friends and customers in the shoe department at the store and could talk about any subject. Among his favorites was Georgia Bulldog football. There is no official record of the men and boys that John Charles fitted with tuxedos for proms and weddings but he touched many hundreds of lives over the years.

John Charles is survived by his loving wife of 25 years, Michelle, and sons Michael, John Ellis, Phillip and Paul. Also surviving are his sisters, June Ellen Mansour Thomas, Rochelle Mansour Norred (Hershall), and brother, Ellis A. Mansour (Melinda), 10 nieces and nephews, 9 great-nieces and nephews, a large loving family and many wonderful friends.
