



John Thomas "J. T." Haynes

November 4, 1932 - October 17, 2010

John Thomas (J. T.) Haynes, Jr. died October 17, 2010. He was born on November 4, 1932 to J. T. Haynes, Sr. and Rebecca Caldwell Haynes who preceded him in death. A graduate of Newnan High School and the University of Georgia, Mr. Haynes was commissioned as a Lieutenant into the U. S. Army where he served 21 months in Korea. After serving in the Army, he worked at The William L. Bonnell Company until his retirement. Mr. Haynes was a lifelong, dedicated member of the Central Baptist Church where he served as an usher until his health failed. An accomplished artist, Mr. Haynes studied under Tom Powers and most recently enjoyed lessons with his friend Martin Pate. His drawing of the Central Baptist Church appears on the church bulletin every Sunday. During the 175th Anniversary celebration of the City of Newnan, Mr. Haynes drew the design for the commemorative plates and other significant mementoes for that celebration. His paintings hang today in many homes here in Coweta County. Mr. Haynes is survived by his wife of fifty years, Norma Chapman Haynes; his daughter, Elizabeth Haynes Homer and his son-in-law, Jack Homer. Also surviving are his sister-in-law, Lynda and her husband, Roger. He is survived by two nephews, Preston and Taylor Moister. A memorial service will be held Tuesday, October 19, 2010 at 2:00 PM in the sanctuary of Central Baptist Church with visitation following in the fellowship hall.
