



Joseph Henry McCabe

May 31, 1930 - January 25, 2015

Joseph H. McCabe, age 84, passed away Sunday, January 25, 2015 at his home in Senoia surrounded by family. He was born May 31, 1930 in Brooklyn, NY to the late James McCabe and Nora Sheehan McCabe.

Joseph was a wonderful father and a very giving man. He exemplified the core values of the Catholic faith and was a member of St. George Catholic Church and St. Mary Magdalene Catholic Church. He served in the National Guard and was a master carpenter for most of his life. He retired 20 years ago.
