Mrs. Judy Carolyn Strength Newman passed away peacefully at home on Sunday, November 3, 2024, surrounded by her family. Judy was one of 11 children born to Willie Paul Strength and Frances Jones Strength. She was born on January 7, 1945, in Lee County, Alabama and raised in Fairfax, Alabama, graduating from Valley High School in 1963.

Following her graduation, she joined West Point Pepperell sewing towels in the mill located in Fairfax. It was while working at the mill that she met the love of her life, Joe Newman, Jr., an industrial engineer who was also employed by West Point Pepperell. Joe was a Georgia boy, born and raised, in Newnan, Georgia. It wasn't long before they began dating and were married at the First Baptist Church in Fairfax on August 19, 1966.
