Karen Elaine Bauman Helms, Major, U.S. Air Force, retired, 62, of Newnan passed away Friday, November 8, 2019 at Brightmoor Hospice. She was born September 10, 1957 in Orlando, FL to the late Paul & Rose Bauman.

In 1979, Karen graduated from the University of Alabama and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the US Air Force Nurse Corps. Her first duty assignment was a clinical nurse, 4th Tactical Hospital, 4th Tactical Fighter Wing, Seymour Johnson Air Force Base, North Carolina. In 1986, Karen was reassigned as an individual mobility augmentee to the 9019th Air Reserve Squadron and assigned to the Tactical Hospital, 48th Tactical Fighter Wing, RAF Lakenheath, East Anglia, United Kingdom. She also served the 89th Medical Group, Andrews AFB, Washington, DC. In 1990, Karen was mobilized during Operation Desert Storm in Iraq where she was assigned as a nurse at an aero medical evacuation center to treat wounded warriors returning from the theater of operations. Her last assignment was the 94th Airlift Wing, Dobbins Air Reserve Base, Georgia. After 20 years of honorable service, Karen retired from the United States Air Force Reserves with the rank of Major. Karen also cared for numerous patients during her time as a Nurse at Piedmont Newnan Hospital.

The visitation is Sunday evening, November 17, 2019 between 5:00-7:00 at McKoon Funeral Home, 38 Jackson Street, Newnan. The graveside service,

with military honors, is Monday, November 18, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. at Georgia National Cemetery, 1080 Scott Hudgens Drive, Canton, GA 30114 with Rev. Don Helms officiating.
