Katherine "Kitty" Cooper Mosley, 69 of Newnan, GA, formerly of Montgomery, AL passed away Tuesday, December 6, 2016 at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. Kitty was born October 4, 1947 in Montgomery to the late Byron Lynn Cooper and Sarah Elizabeth Nunnelee Cooper. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by husband of 40 years, Donald Lee Mosley and sister, Barbara Cooper Smythe.

Kitty grew up in Montgomery where she graduated from Robert E. Lee High School in 1965. She received both her undergraduate degree in English Language Arts and her Master's in School Administration and Instructional Supervision from Auburn University. Kitty taught elementary school in the Montgomery Public School System for many years. She was the Publisher/Editor of Chalk Dust magazine from 1987 to 1994.
