Kim Frederking, 69, passed away on Sunday, January 18, 2026. Born and raised in Miami, Florida, Kim made her home in Newnan, Georgia, where she lived for the past 37 years in one of the historic homes of downtown Newnan. Her family and friends find comfort in knowing that she is now at peace and reunited with her beloved husband of more than 40 years, Scott Frederking.

Kim was born with a generous heart, and a deep sense of dedication to both her family and her community. She graduated from Auburn University in 1977 with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, laying the foundation for a distinguished career in business, finance, and nonprofit leadership.

Her professional career began at Bank of America, where she worked from 1977 to 1986 and rose to the position of Assistant Vice President. From 1986 to 1989, she served as Vice President of ABN Amro North America, Inc., followed by her role as Director at CIBC Oppenheimer Securities from 1989 to 1997. Kim later dedicated her expertise to the nonprofit sector as Executive Director of The Coweta Community Foundation from 1999 to 2001. While her children were in grade school, she also held part-time positions with The Community Foundation of Greater Atlanta before retiring from professional work to focus fully on her family and home.

Kim was deeply involved in her community. She was a member of the

Newnan-Coweta Chamber of Commerce and the Newnan-Coweta Historical Society. She devoted significant time to The Heritage School, serving as PTA President and as a member of the Board of Trustees. A proud Delta Zeta alumna of Auburn University, Kim especially cherished volunteering with the sorority while both of her daughters were members at Auburn.

Outside of her professional and civic life, Kim embraced many passions. She was an accomplished and enthusiastic Sicilian cook, loved art and crafting, and was a devoted Auburn football fan. Above all, Kim had an extraordinary love for animals-she was rarely without at least three pets in her home and generously volunteered her time at the Newnan Humane Society.

Kim is survived by her daughter Emma Rose of Atlanta; daughter Amanda (Weston) Yeager of Asheville, NC; aunt Beverly Williamson; and aunt Phyllis Levin.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Scott Frederking; her mother, Rosalee Hanson; her father, Charles Marcinak; and her stepfather, Robert Hanson.

Kim will be remembered for her intelligence, warmth, generosity, and unwavering devotion to her family, community, and the causes she held dear. Her legacy of service, kindness, and love lives on in all who knew her.
