Lee H. Enloe, II, age 85, of Newnan, GA passed away Friday, January 10, 2020. Born in Decatur, AL, on September 1, 1934 to Lee Heyman Enloe and Cornelia Harris Enloe, and raised in Gadsden, AL, Mr. Enloe was a proud graduate of Gadsden High School and, continuing his family's legacy, the Georgia Institute of Technology. An architect, builder, sports field designer, and entrepreneur, he owned a variety of businesses over the course of his professional career. More importantly, he was a loving and devoted father, grandfather, great-grandfather and long-standing parishioner and Eucharistic Minister at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Newnan. Along with his parents, Mr. Enloe is preceded in death by his wife of 27 years, Juanita Ard Enloe.
