Mrs. Linda Cochran McWaters died early Monday, October 14, 2013, after waging a year-long battle with acute myeloid leukemia. The daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Alton Cochran, Mrs. McWaters was born in Canton, Georgia, on December 14, 1938. The family relocated to Carrollton, Georgia, where she was a majorette with the Trojans Marching Band, a member of the Class of 1956, and a student at West Georgia College.

Married to the late Bill McWaters, Mrs. McWaters worked for over 30 years in the Coweta County medical community, retiring in December of 2011 from PAPP Clinic. She was a member of Unity Baptist Church and a sustaining member of the Newnan Junior Service League.

A loving mother, sister, and grandmother, she leaves behind daughters, Mrs. Kay Cawthon(Marshall), Ms. Misty McWaters; grandchildren, Meg Morgan(Tommy), Matthew Cawthon(Molly), Sara McWaters and Emily McWaters and great-granddaughter, Margaret Bailey Morgan, all of Newnan, sisters, Mrs. Carole C.
