Lon E. Morris, Jr. (L.E. aka "Big Daddy") passed away on October 7, 2017 at the age of 97. He had a full and productive life. He was born on August 27, 1920 to Lon Morris, Sr. and Lula Williamson Morris in Newnan, Ga. He is preceded in death by his wife of 64 years, Hilda Morgan Morris and his three siblings, Billy Morris, Evelyn Morris Boswell and Fred Morris. 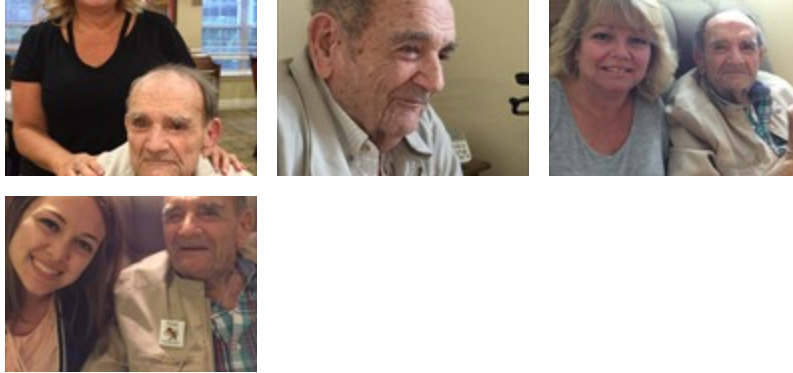
