Ms. Lorraine O'Brien McMahon, 81, of Newnan, passed away on Friday, September 20, 2024. She was born in Philadelphia, PA to the late John and Florence O'Brien. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her son, Kevin Sean McMahon, and two sisters, Dorothy O'Brien and Margaret O'Brien.

Lorraine graduated from Saint Maria Goretti High School in 1960 and began her career working in the US Navy recruitment center in Philadelphia.
