



## Lynda Dell Quick

April 28, 1948 - August 13, 2024

Lynda Dell Quick, 76, of Turin passed away Tuesday, August 14, 2024. She was born in Troup County, Georgia to the late Sidney Dell and June Simmons Dell. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Steve Quick.

Lynda grew up in Turin, graduated from East Coweta High School and later graduated from West Georgia where she earned a Master's Degree. At East Coweta, Lynda excelled at basketball, averaging 35 points per game with a record high 59 points in a single game (although she claimed she scored more but they ran out of room to record them). Later, she became a basketball referee in the West Georgia Officials Association where she was the only woman ref among 56 male referees and only 1 of 27 female refs in the state of Georgia. She earned her way to refereeing playoff games and became the first woman to ref a high school state playoff game.

After retiring from Coweta County Water, she devoted her time, effort and heart to volunteering to work with individuals with special needs, The Special Olympics and The Pink Posse.

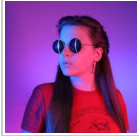
