Mable Virginia Boydstone, aka Nickie, 85, of Acworth, GA passed peacefully on February 3, 2020 one day shy of her 86th birthday.

Nickie was born on February 4, 1934 in Lindale, Georgia to the late Robert M. Nixon and Evie Lou Williams. As a teenager, she was involved in sports notably basketball. After graduating from Pepperell High School, she decided to join the Air Force. While stationed at F. E. Warren AFB in Wyoming, she had the opportunity to continue playing the sport that she loved for the Women's Service Team. It was here that she met Joseph O. Boydstone, Jr also stationed at F. E.
