Mae Rose Newsom Stone, 93, of Newnan, formerly of Albany, GA and Columbus, GA, died Monday, December 11, 2017 at Wesley Woods. She was married to J. K. Stone for 52 years before his death on December 12, 1994. Born in Geneva County, AL, she was a daughter of Domingus “Bud” Newsom and Theodosia Hinson Newsom.
