David served in the War in Iraq, where he was given the nickname "Omni" by his battle buddies. David was injured and honorably discharged, earning him The Purple Heart. David then returned to work for Coweta County Department of Corrections from which he recently retired after working for Coweta for 32 years. He had a passion for fishing, and playing his guitars and keyboard, but most of all he loved his Coca-Cola. David had a sense of humor as well as a heart like no other. During his time on earth, he proudly fought for our Country and treated everyone equally, even the county's prisoners. David changed so many lives.
