I once took my three year old in with what began with a swollen knee, which he said he hurt on his bike. Xrays showed no break. Within a day or two his other knee became swollen and inflamed. All this time he would play a while and lounge a while. In the course of one day his hips became so painful he cried when picked up. Alarmed I scooped him up and even though it was Friday afternoon after 4, Dr Cole waited for me to bring him in. After doing a quick exam he was certain he had Rheumatic Fever! I was directed to take him to Newnan Hospital for an Echocardiogram to check for heart valve damage. So frightening! Thankfully Penicillin and Ibuprofen healed him nicely. He was very reassuring when moms got upset. I was the crying kind of upset. He also met me at his office one Sunday morning before Church to loan me a Nebulizer and meds because my newborn was having breathing issues. I will be forever grateful to him for the genuine concern and love for the generations of Newnanites he cared for. Thankfully my babies had the best care due in no small part to this son of Newnan who made children his business..his kind will never be again and will be sorely missed. Thanks Dr. Cole. For everything.
