Marc Anthony Jordan, 58, of Sharpsburg, passed away at his home on Monday, March 17, 2025. He was born June 13, 1966 in Queens, New York, to Robert Thomas Jordan and the late Majol Ann Bish. He is survived by his wife of 22 years, Mary Ellen Bishop Jordan and his children Lauran Hicks, Stephan, Anthony, and Lance Jordan. Also a granddaughter, Avalon Hicks. In addition to his father, he is survived by a sister Ann (Bob) of Senoia and brothers John (Terri) of Wetumpka, AL; Craig (Carol) Jordan and Scott (Sherry) Jordan of Newnan, and Sean Jordan of Atlanta. He is also survived by many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Growing up in a military family allowed him to live in different locations including Okinawa, Japan, Beaufort, S.C., Virginia, and Newnan. He considered Newnan his home, where he graduated from Newnan High School in 1985. He spent two years in the Air Force before joining the Clayton County Sheriff's Department followed by the Clayton County Police Department, where he retired after a combined 30 years. As a man who enjoyed cooking he and Mary Ellen began his second career in the barbecue business. Tactical Smoke BBQ became well-known and sought after throughout Coweta and surrounding counties.

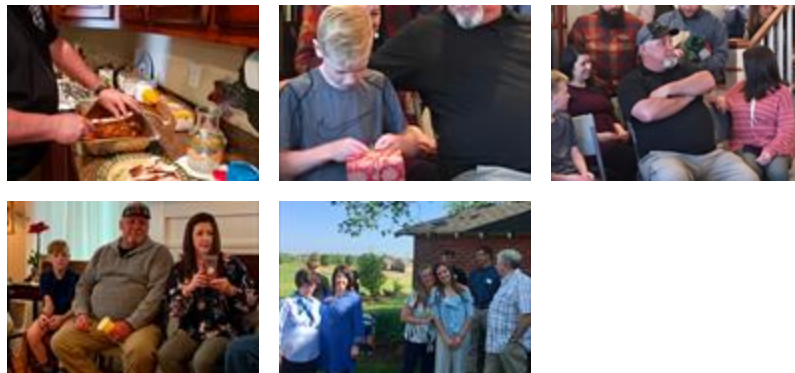

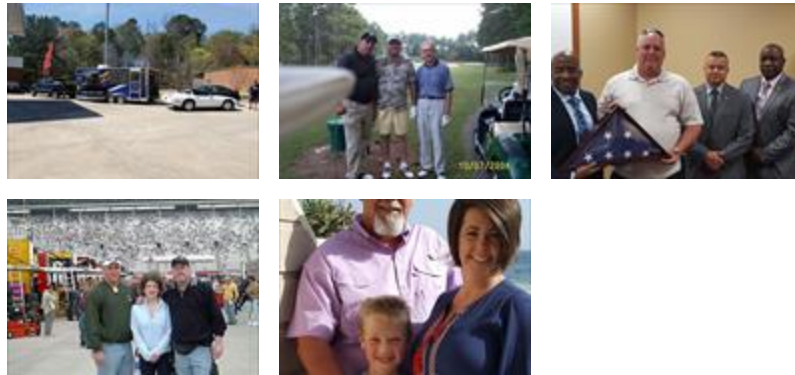
