Mark Lawrence Manning age 60 of Newnan, GA, passed away suddenly on Sunday, March 3rd 2019. Born in Chester, Pennsylvania to Mary and William Manning. Mark lived in Norwood and Glenolden, Pennsylvania for forty years until moving to Georgia in March of 1999 to work as an airplane mechanic for Atlantic Southeast Airlines.
