



## Marnie Lewis Foreman

October 23, 1939 - August 1, 2023

Mr. Marnie Lewis Foreman, 83, of Newnan, Georgia passed away on August 1, 2023 surrounded by loved ones. He was born October 23, 1939, in Linden, Texas to the late Horace Dudley and Anne Mae Foreman. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister Carrie Foreman Strain; brother, Richard Foreman; and granddaughter, Rachel Foreman Robertson. He is survived by his brother, Ronnie Foreman.

Marnie grew up in Cass County, Texas and entered the U. S. Navy in 1954 at the age of 16. He reenlisted in the U. S. In his military career, Marnie served at Fort Polk, Louisiana; Fort Bragg, North Carolina; Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri; Fort Sam Houston, Texas; and Korea. After retirement as Sergeant First Class, Marnie went on to earn a bachelor's degree in liberal arts from Faulkner State University in Bay Minette, Alabama. In 2006, Marnie and his wife relocated to Newnan, Georgia to be closer to their children.
