Martha Y. Bridges, 89, of Newnan and formerly of Atlanta, died Tuesday, April 18, 2017, in her home. She was born December 1, 1927, in Atlanta, to Leonard L. Young and Martha Cook Young. She was a 1946 graduate of Girls' High School in Atlanta and a 1950 graduate of LaGrange College. She married Robert W. Bridges in February, 1950, and he preceded her in death.
