September 24, 1924 - January 25, 2022

Martha Williams Gill Clark of Senoia, passed away on Tuesday, January 25, 2022, at the age of 97. She was born on September 24, 1924, in the Clover Community of Fayette County, Georgia. She worked at Liberty Mutual Insurance Company in Atlanta, Southern Mills, Inc. in Senoia as Secretary/Bookkeeper and retired as Bookkeeper from Norman W. Paschall Company Inc. in Peachtree City, Georgia after 30 years of service and 34 years for Stephens Warehouse, Inc. where she retired at age 95.

She was a member of the First Baptist Church in Senoia since 1939 where she served for seventeen years as Treasurer and Financial Secretary. She taught Sunday School, Training Union, was Sunbeam Band Director, Historian, WMU Director, Youth Director, and served on various committees. She was a Brownie Scout Leader for a number of years, was a member of the Senoia Historical Society, and was an active member of the community.

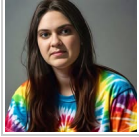
