September 11, 1920 - May 26, 2010

Martha Louise Mooney Hines, age 89, died May 26, 2010 in Newnan. Martha was born September 11, 1920 and was the daughter of the late J. B. and Bessie Lee Owens Mooney. Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband Theodore "Ted" Hines in 1992. They had been married in 1949. Martha received her early education in Newnan and went on to graduate from Vanderbilt. She had started medical school at LSU and did an internship at Grady Hospital in Atlanta as a chemist. She later worked for the Department of Defense in chemical warfare during World War II. Newnan again became the center of her life with her marriage to Ted and the birth of their son Jim. Martha was a gifted floral designer and operated Keheley Florist for some twenty years. Her faith found its resting place in her beloved First Baptist Church. It was there that she taught the Love Sunday School Class for 50 years. When the church decided to decorate a Christmas tree each year, Martha took it upon herself to fashion each ornament with love and her great attention to detail. The Newnan Pilot Club was also a large part of Martha's life. She gave 37 years of dedicated service to that organization and served as president three different times. Martha is survived by her son, Jim Hines and his wife Lisa. Martha's grandchildren are Angela Hines Hendrixson and husband Shannon, James Allen Hines and Alexander Clayton Hines. Her great grandchildren are Ted, Sarah Grace, Madeline Hendrixson and James Allen Hines, Jr. Funeral arrangements are by McKoon Funeral Home at 38 Jackson Street where the family will receive friends on Friday beginning at
