Martha Bowers Guffin Reese, 92, passed away Thursday, July 21, 2011 in Auburn, AL. She taught mathematics for thirty years; particularly enjoying facilitating student learning in the classroom and through travel. She traveled extensively both domestically and internationally. She served as a temporary missionary to Africa and to Japan, building friendships that lasted for many years. Martha taught adult Sunday school for over seventy years and was recognized by all who knew her as a tremendous Bible scholar and teacher. Her faith and commitment to her church have been a strong and integral part of Martha. She serves as a shining example to all who have known her.

She is survived by her daughters, Peggy Trout of VA, Nancy Golson of Auburn, AL; her son, Tom Guffin of Memphis, TN; her brother, Lisle Bowers of Newnan, GA; her sister, Betty Darden of Brandon, FL; grandchildren, Gretchen Pascoe, Lara Adelberger, Brian Golson, Neil Golson; and eight
