Merry Ellen Arace (Pickel), 72, of Newnan, Georgia, passed away peacefully at home on February 23, 2025. Born on March 18, 1953 in Barton, Vermont, she was the daughter of the late Bob Pickel and Joyce Merrill Pickel.
