This world lost a beautiful soul, devoted husband, tremendous father, and a deeply loved son, uncle, cousin, friend, and mentor in Michael "Mike" Edward Ahrens on June 11, 2022. ALS (Lou Gehrig's Disease) could take his body, but it never, ever took his ever-present infectious smile, his wicked sense of humor or his tremendous strength and grace. He won his toughest battle.
