Michael Bock II was born in Buffalo, NY in 1918 to Charles and Stella N. Bock. He was an Eagle Scout and enjoyed camping trips with the troops every summer. After graduating from high school Mike entered Lehigh University. He graduated in 1939 with a degree in Metallurgy. During the war he worked as a civilian for the Naval Ship Yards in Boston, MA and has U.S. and foreign patents on products relating to exothermic and welding processes. In 1946 he started Exomet Inc. in Conneaut, OH where he was a Vice-President. The company was purchased by Air Products and Chemicals Inc. in 1967. In 1977 he went to Greenville, PA as General Manager of Air Products Metals Recovery. He and his partners purchased the recovery operation in 1984 which became Greenville Metals, and became President until he retired in 1999. He received congratulations from the state of Pennsylvania. The document was sponsored by Senator Robert D. Robbins and is signed by him. Mr. Bock served on the board of Brown Memorial Hospital in Conneaut, OH as a trustee and President for 24 years.

Michael Bock II was preceded in death by his parents and his sister Dr. Betty Bock. He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Frances and daughter Lisa and her husband David V. Holec.
