Michael B. Norred was born in Roanoke, Alabama on September 17, 1947. He proudly served in Vietnam as a Marine (Once a Marine, always a Marine!). He married Judy in 1971, with two sons, Stan and Andrew, whom he loved deeply and loved to brag about them whenever given any opening in conversation.

Michael started his career as a homebuilder and built his own home from the ground up with only his wife and sons as assistants (and supervisors.)
