helping others. Mike was larger than life and even nicknamed himself "MacDaddy." He made few, if any, enemies. He was passionate; he loved hard; and he never abandoned anyone in need.

We will all miss his humor and his courage but most of all his unconditional love of us all! He taught us all faith, courage, and grace while fighting cancer the last three years of his life. He fought the good fight and ran a good race. It was time for him to be pain-free and carefree and join his loved ones.
